

CHILDREN IN NEED

Thank you for your support with this annual charity event, we raised an amazing £306.40 all of which was donated to Children in Need.

READING BOOKS

You may have noticed that the children have brought home some new reading books this week (bands pink to gold). This was the next stage of our project to ensure that our reading scheme is closely aligned to the phonics knowledge that the children are taught when they are learning to read in their daily Read Write Inc. lessons (RWI). This supports improved progress: the sequence of reading books shows a cumulative progression in phonics knowledge and gives pupils practice in reading and re-reading books that match the grapheme-phoneme correspondences they have already been taught. Children should be able to read their home reading book with relative ease, allowing them to focus on developing their skills of fluency, expression and comprehension; reading challenge is taught in school during RWI lessons. Some of the books have additional information for parents to support with comprehension so please have a look to see if your child's book has this.

Thank you to Miss Applegarth for the extensive work in auditing and ordering new books. Our next stage is beyond gold band and to keep existing books replenished.

SHARING ASSEMBLIES

We were disappointed to have to postpone Badger and Hedgehog sharing assemblies this term due to the revised restrictions from the Local Authority. I am 'crystal ball gazing' and anticipating that restrictions may not change over the next few months. I have therefore taken the decision to postpone other sharing assemblies that are taking place next term and to move everything to March onwards where hopefully we can welcome parents in to the school hall again.
