SPORTS DAY ~ Friday 5th July

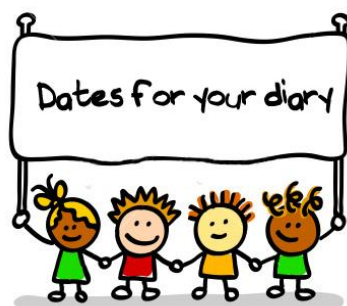
